League Description

- I. Type of League
 - a. This is a head-to-head, dynasty style fantasy football league. A dynasty league is a type of league that honors salary cap of the NFL, allows teams to retain most of their roster (minus traded players, or dropped players) from year to year. Dynasty leagues are more intrusive for managers who are looking for that little bit more from a fantasy football environment.
 - b. By-Laws the league managers will vote on all league rule changes, scoring changes, fee changes, league expansion, and roster expansion
- II. Amount of teams
 - a. There is a maximum of ten teams in this dynasty league.
 - b. Each team can have no more than two (2) managers.
 - c. League voted to increase number of teams from 8 to 10. (2022)
- III. Division(s)
 - a. League is comprised of a single division as voted by the league (2021).
- IV. Dynasty League Web Host
 - a. Currently, this league will be hosted by Real Sports Online (www.realitysportsonline.com)
- V. Keepers
 - a. A keeper league allows teams to keep/retain a player they choose from the previous year's draft.
- VI. Back-to-Back Award
 - a. The league has a Back-to-Back (B2B) award for a team that wins consecutive (must be consecutive years) titles. This money pot accumulates until a team wins it.
 - b. If the league dissolves before the B2B award have been awarded, the Commissioner ('mish) will disburse to each manager what that manager has contributed to the B2B award.

- c. If a manager leaves the active league before the B2B award has been given, that manager will forfeit all their donations to the B2B award.
- VII. League Logon & Password
 - a. Pork Butt is a private league hosted by RSO. This selection requires our league to utilize a community (for all invitees to join the league) Logon & Password to join the league. This is different than the Username and Password that each manager will be required by RSO to create to access their (RSO) website.
 - b. League Logon- Merica
 - c. League Password- 50cc3rSuck5!

League Monies

- I. League Fee
 - a. Each team will have a \$50 (USD) league fee that is payable to the league, and an RSO fee that is payable to the ‘Mish (see League Monies, Article II, Section b.) Each team’s yearly league fees will consist of current league fee + RSO fee (2021).
 - b. League Fees will be accepted by electronic payment via these methods:
 - i. Pay-Pal
 - ii. Venmo
 - iii. ~~Facebook Messenger~~
 - iv. ~~Zelle~~
 - c. ~~Due to the monies our league has (RSO fee, League fee, B2B award) our league will not accept cash, or personal checks. This allows easier tracking of all monies that the league accepts and disburses.~~
- II. Web Dynasty League Fee
 - a. RSO requires that each league they host has a league fee. This is separate from the League Fee mentioned in Article I of the League Monies section. Currently, RSO charges \$12.99 (USD) per team. This must be paid before a manger can access their team on the RSO website.
 - b. ‘mish will pay each team’s RSO fee for the current season (2021).
- III. B2B Award
 - a. Each year, the ‘mish will pull \$5 (USD) from each team’s league fee. This is the yearly ante to the B2B Award.
 - i. There is no official “pull” for the B2B ante. The ‘mish will simply remove this money from the league fees and hold it in a credit union account that is used for the league banking.
 - b. This award is only given to a team that wins consecutive, back-to-back, Pork Butt titles.

- i. If a team wins the B2B award for consecutive titles (2), then wins the consecutive year for a third consecutive title, that team will be awarded the refreshed B2B pot.
- c. This pot continues to grow each season (\$5 per team) until it has been awarded.
- d. After the B2B has been awarded, the pot restarts the following season with the \$5 ante from each team.
- e. The B2B award will be paid out to the team that has earned it when the league End of Season Payouts are given.

IV. End of Season Payouts

- a. End of season payouts will be completed electronically within fourteen (14) days of the league championship game completion.
- ~~b. Divisional Winner is a team that wins their regular season division. This winner will receive \$15 (USD) for this accomplishment. The league has two (2) Divisional Winners per season. One team will be from the West, and the other team will be from the East. (2021)~~
- c. Third place overall is a team that wins the game between the losers of playoff round one. This team will earn \$50 (USD) for this accomplishment. The league will have one (1) Third place team per year.
- d. Second place overall is a team that loses the championship game (AKA Pig Parlor). This team will receive \$100 (USD) for this accomplishment. The league will have one (1) Second place team per year.
- e. First place overall is a team that wins the championship game (AKA Pig Parlor). This team will receive \$300 (USD) for this accomplishment. The league will have one (1) First place team per year.

V. Ledger

- a. At the beginning of each season (or on a manager's request) the 'mish will provide each manager with a league Ledger of the league finances of monies out, and monies in.

League Rules

I. Keeper

- a. Pork Butt league does not use traditional keepers because each player on the manger's team is under a termed length contract. The manager maintains the player until the contract is up, or they trade the player, or release the player to Free Agency.

II. Draft

- a. The Rookie Draft will be held third Sunday of May of the current season. The Rookie Draft will be held online via RSO's website. The draft will be held every year at the 'Mish's residence. The draft will be of three (3) rounds. (2021)

III. UFAA

- a. UFAA will be held on the second Saturday of August of the current season. The UFFA will be held online via RSO's website. (2021)

IV. Draft Positions

- a. Draft positions (except league inaugural year) will be determined by regular season standings. The team with the worse regular season record will hold the #1 pick in the following year draft. While the team with the best regular season record will hold the #10 pick in the following year draft.

~~b. Draft positions for the inaugural year will be done completely by blind draw. The draw will be playing cards 1-10 shuffled~~

~~and laid out face down. Each manager will choose a card, the number that is on the face of the card is the manager's draft slot. Managers are allowed (before the draft) to trade their draft slot with other managers. (2022)~~

V. Trades & Claims

- a. Pork Butt Dynasty league does not introduce a fee for trading, adding, or dropping a player to or from their team. There is a possibility that a manager will occur cap penalty if they acquire a player that places that team over the NFL yearly cap. See league rules on RSO for more detailed explanation of NFL cap & penalties.
- b. The league structure allows teams to retain players during the offseason. This allows managers of the league to trade, drop, or add players to or from their team during the off season.
- c. The league uses a one (1) day Waiver wait period. Please see league rules on RSO for more details.
- d. The league uses a one (1) day Free Agent wait period. Please see the league rules on RSO for more details.
- e. The league will honor the NFL trade deadline period.
- f. For a complete list of the league rules, please visit our league on RSO.

VI. Rule/League/Scoring Changes

- a. All rule, league, and scoring changes will be voted upon by all acting managers. For a rule or league change, majority of the vote will decide if the rule or league change is accepted.
- b. All league/rule changes will be voted upon sixty (60) days prior to the draft. Voting will be allowed via electronic means only. This will ensure there is a record of the voted item. ~~or verbal communication (2021).~~
- c. There will be no rule/league changes made after the sixty (60) day period before the draft, and or during the regular season

or playoffs. *If a rule/league change is voted upon, that rule/league change will take affect the following year. (2021)*

VII. Governmental Politics in league

- a. League voted in 2021 to enact for seasons 2022 and beyond that if a manager talks, directs, insults, or slanders any topic about Governmental Politics to the rest of the league in a digital manner, that manager will be deducted five points from their upcoming matchup. (2021)

VIII. Expansion Draft

- a. League voted in 2022 to enact an expansion draft to accommodate new teams to the league.
- b. League voted in 2022 that existing teams cannot lose more than seven (7) existing players to the expansion draft. This vote ended in a tie, which was immediately decided by coin toss rule VIX.

IX. Coin Toss

- a. If a league vote ends in a tie, the commissioner will decide the outcome via coin toss.
- b. The coin toss must be validated via video of such toss or witnessed by at least one (1) other manager.
- c. If the coin toss is videotaped, the video must be uploaded to league website for archives, and other owner viewing.

X. Field Goal Scoring Adjustment

- a. Missed Field Goal from 0-39 yards will be -3 points.
- b. Missed Field Goal from 40-49 yards will be -2 points.
- c. Missed Field Goal from 50+ yards will be 0 points deducted.

XI. Non-QB thrown TD scoring adjustment.

- a. Score was changed from three (3) to six (6)

XII. Rivalry Week (initiated in 2023 by a vote of 5 ayes, 0 naes, 1 idc)

- a. Week 13 is designated for Rivalry Week.*
- b. The league fee was increased from \$50 to \$60.*
- c. Monies from losing teams will be put toward the purchase of the Championship Pint glass. Remaining funds will be put toward rookie draft meal.*

XIII. The Sack

- a. The award for the team that finishes last.*
- b. The person who finished last will have their picture taken with The Sack. That picture will be placed on the website's Sack page.*
- c. The person who wins The Sack, has to change their team logo to their picture of them wearing The Sack for the current season.*

XIV. New team roster drop

- a. New managers that inherit an empty (but already existing team) can drop some players from their roster. The dead cap of the contracts will be deduced fifty percent (50%) by the 'mish.*

Season

I. Length

- a. Pork Butt regular season is thirteen NFL weeks. This range is from NFL week one (1) to NFL week thirteen (13).**
- b. The playoffs of our league cover NFL weeks fourteen (14) & fifteen (15). First round of playoffs is NFL week fourteen (14). Championship (Pig Parlor) is NFL week fifteen (15).**

Rosters

- I. Playable positions
 - a. Each team will have the ability to play these positions in their weekly lineup.
 - i. QB, RB, WR, TE, Flex, K, D/ST
 - b. Roster breakdown is as follows:
 - i. QB max on team is two
 - ii. RB max on team is four

- iii. WR max on team is nine
 - iv. TE max on team is three
 - v. K max on team is two
 - vi. D/ST max on team is two
 - c. Weekly lineup submissions are as follows:
 - i. QB in lineup is one
 - ii. RB in lineup is two
 - iii. WR in lineup is three
 - iv. TE in lineup is one
 - v. Flex in lineup is one
 - vi. K in lineup is one
 - vii. D/ST in lineup is one
- II. Roster size
 - a. The total amount of players a team can have on their roster is twenty-two (22) (not including IR).
 - b. Each team will be allowed six (6) IR spots.
