### Chaka v Dave

#### Rich v Brandon

However, looking at the averages, I do not see Andrew's 106.75 competing against Dino's 132.80. Dino wins, keeping his team alive for the sixth seed.

### Sky v Jason

One versus two in this matchup. Both teams have electric, efficient offenses. Jason has already secured a playoff spot; Sky's magic number is one. Hard game to predict here as Sky is averaging 168.15 and Jason is averaging 174.70. Sky needs to win to retain the two seed (especially if Jake wins this week), but I am taking Jason in this matchup. I do hope the numbers are not lying.

## Playoffs

- 1. Jason: Nothing changes this week for Jason despite taking his first loss, the number one seed is still his.
- 2. Sky: Magic number is one to grasp one of the last five playoff spots.
- 3. Jake: Enjoying a modest two game winning streak he is sitting nicely as the third seed and can see the gates to the post-season. The highest he could enter the playoffs would be the two seed, the lowest would be the sixth seed. I see him entering the playoffs as the three seed.
- 4. Dave: Needing a come from behind win to remain relevant, the road is still muddy, as his next three opponents are contenders (two of the three are currently one and two seeds). - 4. Dino: Coming this week his chances looked good, but after losing this week they are bleak. Still not out of the hunt but being left behind at the paddock. If he wins out, he will finish with seven wins and a sixth seed. However, he will need help, and lots of it (remarkably like Mike's scenario). He would need Dave and Chaka to lose two of their last three games, while Brandon and Mike lose all of theirs.
- 4. Mike: Continuing his losing streak, currently at four games now he is watching the playoffs slip further from his reach. He needs to win out, have Dave and Chaka lose two, Brandon and Dino lose three. Even with this scenario, the most wins he can accumulate is seven.
- 9. Rich: Losing a heartbreaker this week, his playoff hopes are quite simple. Slim and none. He must win out to hopefully squeak in as the sixth seed.
- 10. Andrew: After losing to Jake this week he has been mathematically eliminated and entered the role of spoiler. It is time to start thinking about the 2026 season.
